- 1. As national rules allow for no substitution of team members, once a team is formed a student is expected to remain with the team throughout the period of competition. The Regional Tournament will be **March 7**th, **2015** at Springbank Middle School. The Provincial Tournament will be in Grande Prairie March 14th, 2015. Teams **must** be able to attend **one** of the tournaments to qualify for Destination Imagination Global Finals. 80% of the team members must be available to attend the tournament.
- 2. Most practice sessions will be during school hours although additional practices may be scheduled after school or on the weekends as we approach tournament season. All team members will be expected to attend. You must attend at least 80% of the practices to participate in the tournament.
- 3. Team members are expected to seek permission and make up material that is missed during team practices held during school hours.
- 4. Students must have a willing attitude to share, to cooperate, and be flexible.
- 5. Students must realize that these sessions must be productive and not wasted by unfocused activities.
- 6. Parents are required to transport their children to and from all practices that take place outside of school hours.
- 7. Students and their parents need to discuss the commitment that being a member of a DI team requires and the responsibilities membership implies before jointly making the decision to become a DI member.
