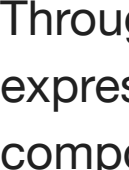

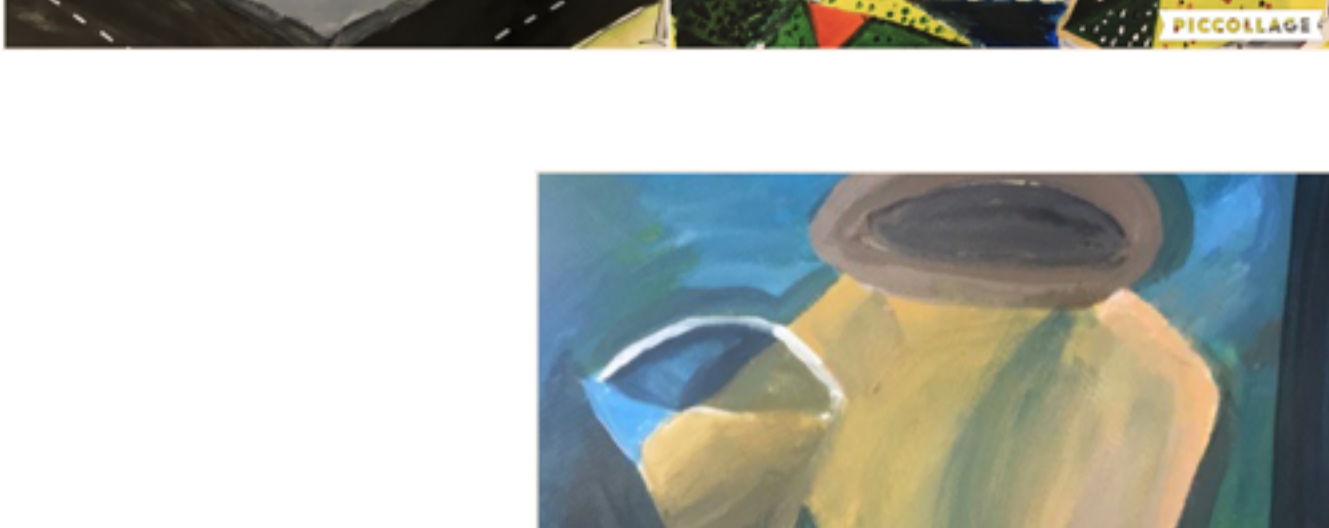
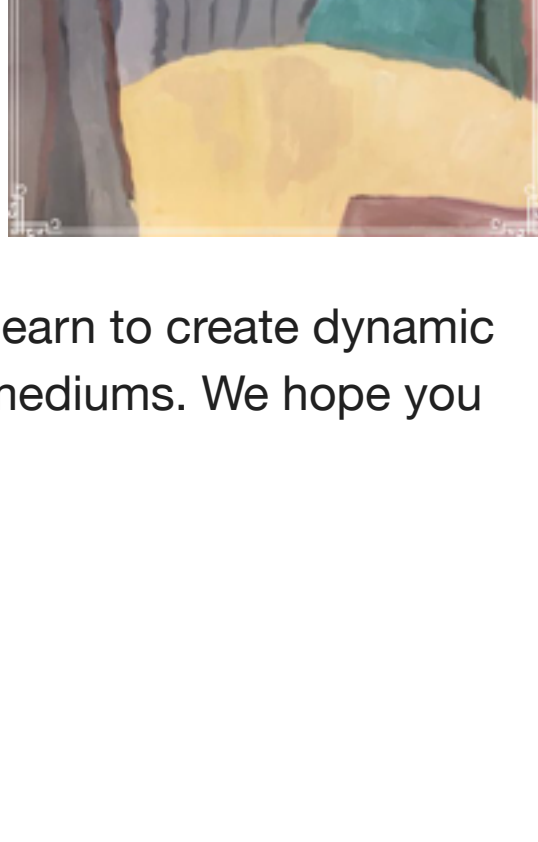
Did you know that Springbank Middle School Art program has an Instagram account?

Pink Shirt Day & Anti-Bullying Presentations

On Tuesday, February 23, Dr. Crystal Dittrick (RVS Psychologist, formerly attached to SMS) did an interactive anti-bullying presentation for our Grade 7 students. Students broke into groups and discussed topics such as the difference between bullying and conflict; the different types of bullying; and what makes cyberbullying unique. They also discussed why we should care and what we can do as a community and as individuals to stop bullying. Some students volunteered to take part in a role playing exercise where one student would conduct an "interview", by asking the "guests" how they would respond in a given scenario. Each guest would respond as a bully, a helper, or a bystander. The interviewer would then choose who they would prefer to associate with, given their response. At the end of the presentation, every grade 7 student was entered into a draw for a pink shirt package (pink shirt, pink colour changing pencil, and pink bracelet). Our winners were: Ava, Chase, Lucas, Ava and Emily.

Mark your calendars! The fun and excitement of a Scholastic Book Fair is coming to our school!

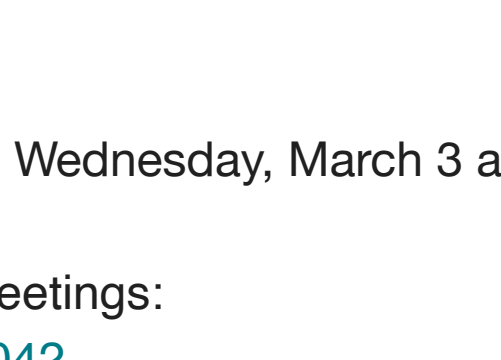
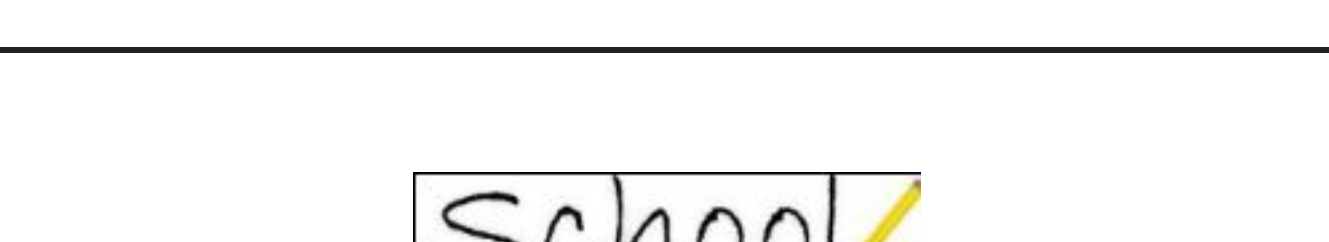

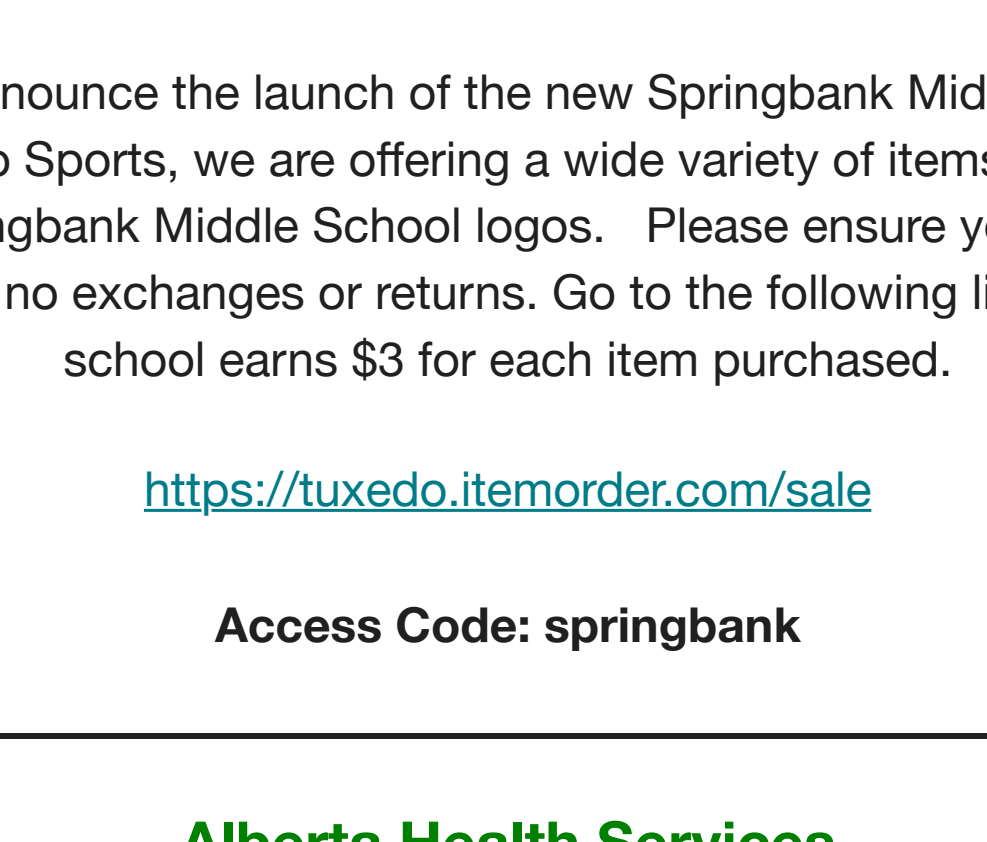
